**DATE :** June 9, 2025

The Department of Education (DepEd) and Khan Academy Philippines Inc. (KA PH) will conduct activities aligned to DepEd's vision of reinforcing foundational skills in literacy and numeracy, revitalizing Reading, Science, and Math programs, and supporting teachers and learners with technology to maximize the benefits of digital and remote learning.

Khan Academy is currently conducting school verification while the first online session for teacher implementers will transpire this June 14, July 5 and 12, 2025. After Session 1, the succeeding 2 sessions are face-to-face. Below is the description, objective and expected outcomes of each:

**Session 2: Getting Started with Khan Academy**

This session is designed to provide educators with a comprehensive understanding of the various features of the Khan Academy platform—including access to instructional resources, assessments, and progress monitoring tools—and how these elements can supplement classroom instruction and support a growth mindset among learners.

By the end of the training, participants will be able to demonstrate a clear understanding of the key features of the Khan Academy platform, including how to access and use its resources, assign assessments, and monitor student progress. Teachers will understand how Khan Academy supports a growth mindset for both students and educators by promoting self-paced learning, mastery of concepts, and continuous improvement.

**Session 3: Data-Driven Teaching: How Khanmigo AI Tools and the Teacher Dashboard and Reports Drive Students' Success**

This session is designed to equip educators with the skills to effectively monitor student progress using Khan Academy's dashboards and reports. Participants will learn how to interpret and utilize data to gain insights into student performance, identify learning gaps, and track progress over time to inform instruction, conduct intervention if necessary, and support personalized learning.

In the second half of the session, teachers will be introduced to Khanmigo, Khan Academy's AI-powered teaching assistant. Through a guided walkthrough, they will explore how Khanmigo can support lesson planning, create classroom assessments, reinforce content mastery, manage their class effectively and easily, and enhance instructional delivery.

By the end of the session, participants are expected to demonstrate confidence in using Khan Academy's dashboards to drive data-informed decisions in their classrooms. They will be able to identify trends and gaps in student learning, adapt instruction based on real-time insights, and design more effective, personalized learning experiences.

In line with this, to better prepare the schools and all the stakeholders in the Year 3 implementation of Khan Academy, we would like to inform you about the following training dates for Sessions 2 and 3 we have allotted for each region:
