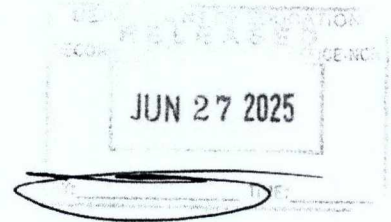

This is to request the authorization of the Department of Education officials to enable teacher-coaches of futsal to attend the third and last futsal training clinic, scheduled for Saturday and Sunday, 12 and 13 July 2025, from 8:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m., at the University of Asia and the Pacific Gym, Ortigas Center, Pasig City.

This third training clinic would comprise those who had attended two previous clinics in Epic Parc, Tanay, mostly from CALABARZON, and those from NCR whose schools have indicated interest in joining the futsal competition for the year.

The envisioned futsal competition for SY 2025-2026 shall involve divisional tournaments that will end up in a selection of regional teams, who could compete in local or national competitions.

The benefit of sports to the character building of the students, if balanced well with academic and cultural life, cannot be over-emphasized. We have seen this on-the-ground during family games and sports festival that we have had in the past two school years.
