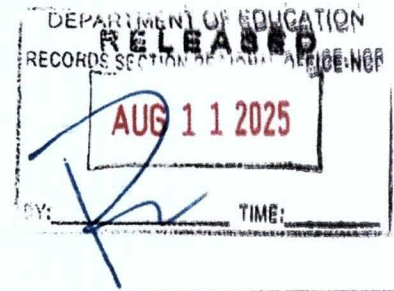

REGIONAL MEMORANDUM

**EMPOWERING LEARNING THROUGH DATA: LEVERAGING KHAN ACADEMY
AND KHAN MIGO FOR ARAL PROGRAM IMPLEMENTATION**

1. In line with the implementation of Republic Act No. 12028, or the ARAL Program Act, and DepEd Order No. 018, s. 2025, the Department of Education – National Capital Region (DepEd NCR), through the Curriculum and Learning Management Division (CLMD) and in collaboration with Khan Academy Philippines, shall conduct a series of trainings titled “Empowering Learning Through Data: Leveraging Khan Academy and Khan Migo for ARAL Program Implementation.”
2. This capacity-building activity seeks to enhance the implementation of the ARAL Program by equipping ARAL tutors and educators with skills to effectively use Khan Academy and Khan Migo as digital tools for personalized instruction and data-driven academic recovery in reading, mathematics, and science. It aims to strengthen the digital and analytical capacity of DepEd personnel and promote evidence-based teaching strategies anchored on learner performance data.
3. The objectives of this activity are to capacitate ARAL Program implementers on the use of Khan Academy and Khan Migo as tools for academic recovery; enhance their skills in interpreting and utilizing learning analytics to create data-informed intervention plans; and strengthen their digital and data literacy to support differentiated instruction aligned with the goals of the ARAL Program.
4. Attached to this memorandum is the Enclosure No. 1, which outlines the detailed training schedule, cluster, assignments, venues, modalities, and corresponding number of participants for each session.
5. All participants are reminded to bring their laptops or tablets, earphones/headsets, and ensure that their devices are fully charged prior to the training. To support potential internet connectivity issues at the venue, participants are also advised to bring their own pocket WiFi or have mobile data available
6. In accordance with DepEd Order No. 013, s. 2024 (Revised Guidelines on the Grant of Vacation Service Credits for Teachers) and CSC-DBM Joint Circular No. 2, s. 2004, teachers who participate in this activity on weekends shall be granted service

credits, while non-teaching personnel and officials may avail of Compensatory Time-Off (CTO), subject to proper documentation and approval by their respective heads of offices.

7. Expenses for meals shall be charged to Regional Office funds under ARAL-related programs, subject to existing budgeting, accounting, and auditing rules and regulations.
