AGIMATH 2026: LSGH Annual Group Interscholastic Math Competition Registration, Rules and Regulations

A. Eligibility

AGIMATH 2026: LSGH Annual Group Interscholastic Math Competition is open to all currently enrolled Grade 10 to Grade 12 students from any school nationwide. Each participating school must have exactly three (3) contestants from any of the eligible grade levels, with one participant representing each category: Algebra, Geometry, and Trigonometry. Participants are required to bring their school ID or proof of identification on the day of the competition.

B. Nature and Coverage of Competition and Coverage

The competition is composed of two parts: an Individual Competition and a Group Competition, covering topics under the area of Algebra, Geometry, and Trigonometry.

C. Individual Competition

1. The three (3) representatives of each participating school shall take a written test.
2. The top three (3) contestants in each category — Algebra, Geometry, and Trigonometry — shall be awarded as first place, second place, and third place, respectively. Hence, all teams are requested to stay until the end of the awarding ceremonies.
3. The score of all the representatives of each school will be added and the total score will be used to determine those who will qualify for the group competition.

D. Group Competition

1. The groups will answer questions from the introductory, intermediate, and advanced levels. Questions from different categories vary in points and time limits.
2. The top three (3) schools with the highest scores after all the rounds shall be awarded as Champion, 1st runner-up, and 2nd runner-up.

E. Registration

1. Registration should be done through <https://bit.ly/AGIMATH2026RegForm> or by scanning the QR code provided below.



2. The deadline for registration is on January 07, 2026 (Wednesday).
3. Registration payments from participating schools should be made upon registration.


