SIMULTANEOUS SCHOOL-LEVEL LAUNCH OF THE ACADEMIC RECOVERY AND ACCESSIBLE LEARNING (ARAL) PROGRAM

1. To strengthen learning recovery initiatives, the Department of Education shall spearhead the nationwide launch of the **Academic Recovery and Accessible Learning (ARAL) Program** on **September 13, 2025 in hybrid format**. This program seeks to address learning gaps, improve learner performance, and ensure that no child is left behind.
2. Relative to the nationwide launch, all schools are hereby instructed to **conduct their respective School-Level ARAL Program Launch during the Flag Raising Ceremony on Monday, September 15, 2025**.
3. School-level launch may include the following:
 - Presentation of the ARAL Program objectives and key features;
 - Introduction of ARAL Program implementers, coordinators, and tutors;
 - Commitment-setting of teachers, learners, parents, and stakeholders;
 - Short symbolic activity (e.g., pledge of support, distribution of ARAL materials).
4. Public Schools District Supervisors (PSDSs) shall monitor the conduct of the school-level launch. Attached is the suggested School-Level Launch Program Flow.
5. School Heads are directed to submit a **brief narrative and photo documentation** of their ARAL Launch to their respective PSDSs, who will consolidate and submit to the Curriculum Implementation Division (CID) not later than **September 20, 2025**.
6. Full cooperation of all concerned is enjoined to ensure the success of this Division-wide undertaking.
