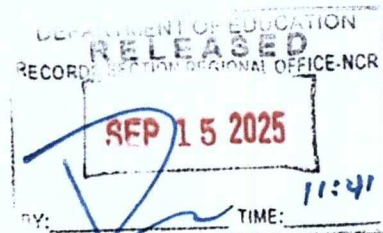

1. The Department of Education – National Capital Region (DepEd-NCR), through the Curriculum and Learning Management Division, and in collaboration with Khan Academy Philippines, will conduct the above-captured activity for information and appropriate action.
