Dear Ms. Gonzales,

Greetings from the Center for the Prevention and Treatment of Child Sexual Abuse (CPTCSA), Inc.!

In partnership with the National Council for Children's Television (NCCT), CPTCSA has co-produced *Tropa Peeps*, a television series that tackles the critical issue of sexual abuse and exploitation of teenage boys. This initiative aims to empower young audiences while fostering awareness, empathy, and resilience.

To further strengthen advocacy and highlight the challenges faced by teenage boys, we are piloting the mainstreaming of *Tropa Peeps* in selected schools in Valenzuela, Muntinlupa, Mandaluyong, and Quezon City. These schools have either implemented or undergone the Personal Safety Lesson (PSL), making them ideal partners in our project on *Systems of Care in Preventing and Responding to Sexual Violence against Boys*.

We are pleased to share with you **DepEd Advisory No. 118, s. 2025**, entitled *Tropa Peeps: A Television Series*, which was approved and published on the DepEd website on June 27, 2025. As part of this initiative, CPTCSA will be conducting activities to document the effectiveness of this material.

For the **first phase**, we will conduct a one-day activity consisting of:

1. Discussion on Basic Child Sexual Abuse
2. Viewing of *Tropa Peeps* with 40 teacher-participants

Following the viewing, the teachers are expected to introduce the series in their classrooms or schools and gather insights and feedback from their students.

In **Part 2**, all 40 teachers will reconvene to consolidate and document the feedback collected, with the **final phase** involving the presentation of documented findings. For your reference, we have attached the tentative program flow.

As Muntinlupa City has been a strong advocate of child protection and a consistent implementer of PSL, we respectfully invite **ten (10) Values Education or GMRC teachers (Elementary and High School) currently teaching PSL or planning to teach PSL** to participate in this activity.

The first activity is scheduled on **October 17, 2025, from 8:00 AM to 5:00 PM** (venue to be announced).

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
