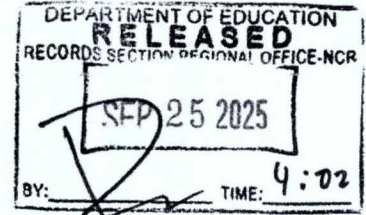

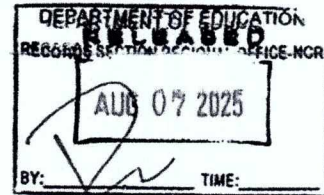

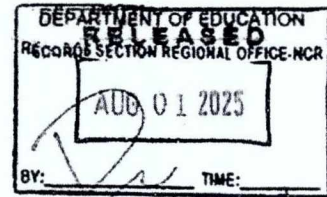

## **PAMES-CASIO- MATHEMATICS CHALLENGE +**

### **OVERVIEW**

The **PAMES CASIO Math Challenge +** is a nation-wide mathematics competition that aims to create a vibrant culture of mathematics across junior and senior high schools in the National Capital Region (NCR). More than just identifying top performers, this challenge is designed to:

- Encourage widespread student participation and excitement in mathematics.
- Provide tangible recognition for a broad range of student achievements.
- Promote school and division pride through structured representation and awards.
- Build community spirit through friendly competition and shared milestones.
- Ensure fairness and transparency through a standardized scoring system.

To achieve these goals, the competition introduces tiered certificates, a clear progression across two rounds, (Semi-Finals and Grade Finals), and a point-based system that rewards both performance and participation. These mechanics have been intentionally designed to align with the goals above and are detailed in the sections that follow.

### **ELIGIBILITY**

#### **1. Participants:**

- Category A: Public Schools (excluding Public Science High Schools)
- Category B: Public Science High Schools, and Private Schools

#### **2. Registration:**

Participants must register through their coach filling up the registration link below.

Schools must submit the following documents for each participant:

- Accomplished registration form.
- Photocopy of the participant's school ID or proof of enrollment.
- Parent/guardian consent form.

#### **3. Calculator Requirement:**

- All participants must use the CASIO FX-570ES PLUS-2CWDT Transparent Calculator during the competition.
- Use of other calculators, models and brands or devices, is **STRICTLY PROHIBITED**.

#### 4. COMPETITION FORMAT

<b>Exam</b>	The competition consists of a one-round written examination. The examination will feature 30 questions divided as follows: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• 10 questions (Easy) – 2 points each.</li> <li>• 10 questions (Moderate) – 3 points each.</li> <li>• 10 questions (Difficult) – 5 points each.</li> </ul> Total score: 100 points.	
<b>Elimination</b>	60% of questions are do-able by most students. 40% are differentiator questions that identify higher-order thinking.	Olympiad Type Questions

<b>Duration</b>	Participants will be given 1.5 hours to complete the exam.

#### COMPETITION RULES

##### 1. Venue

##### 2. Identification:

Participants must wear their school uniform and school ID at all during the event.

##### 3. Prohibited Items:

- Use of mobile phones, smartwatches, or other electronic devices is strictly prohibited.
- Participants found using unauthorized materials or devices will be disqualified.

##### 4. Exam Protocol:

- The use of scratch paper will be allowed; it will be provided by the organizers.
- Calculators must comply with the competition requirement (**CASIO FX-570ES PLUS-2CWDT Transparent Calculator**).

- Participants must stop writing once the time limit is reached; failure to comply will result in penalties.

## JUDGING AND SCORING

### 1. Scoring System:

- 10 questions (Easy) – 2 points each
- 10 questions (Moderate) – 3 points each
- 10 questions (Difficult) – 5 points each

### 2. Tiebreaker:

In case of a tie, a sudden-death round will be conducted. Participants will answer a series of tie-breaker questions until the tie is broken.

## AWARDS AND PRIZES

### 1. Participants:

- **Division Round:** Tiered Certificates will be applied for this year participants.

Certificate	Score Range
Distinction	90 and above
Merit	75–89
Honorable Mention	60–74
Participation	Below 60

**TOP 5 students per grade per division will advance to the regional finals.**

- **Regional Finals Awards:** Certificates, Medals, and Cash prizes for the top 3 scores.
  - 1<sup>st</sup> Place:** Gold Certificate, Gold Medal, and P10,000.00
  - 2<sup>nd</sup> Place:** Silver Certificate, Silver Medal, and P5,000.00
  - 3<sup>rd</sup> Place:** Bronze Certificate, Bronze Medal, and P3,000.00

### 2. School and Division:

- **Division Awards**

The **division score** is calculated as:

$$\text{Division Score} = \frac{\text{Total points earned by all participating schools}}{\text{Total number of schools in the division}}$$

**The Top 3 divisions per category (A and B) will be awarded trophies.**

1. Elimination Round: September 20, 2025
2. Grand Finals: March 14, 2026

### **FINAL PROVISIONS**

By joining the competition, participants agree to abide by all the rules and regulations set by the organizers. Failure to comply with the rules may result in disqualification. Let this event inspire young minds to excel in mathematics and promote the innovative use of CASIO calculators in classrooms.
