


Additional Information

- 5 The SEAMEO RELC Scholarship will cover registration and tuition fees for all the above-mentioned courses. RELC will also provide for one return air ticket and a subsistence allowance for each scholar. For C103, RELC will provide two return tickets due to the two residential phases. For in-person courses and blended courses with residential phases, RELC will provide for the scholars' accommodation for the residential period.
- 6 Shortlisted applicants not residing in Singapore will be required to complete a health declaration and undergo a medical examination in their home countries as part of the application process. The necessary forms and details will be provided to them in due course.
- 7 Course participants are expected to arrive in Singapore one day before the course starts and depart the day after it ends. However, due to flight availability, there may be instances where scholars need to arrive earlier or depart later. Where such a case presents itself, we will inform the scholar of the arrangement. We seek your assistance in releasing the scholars from their work commitments to ensure they arrive for the course on time.
- 8 The MTESOL course includes an Orientation programme prior to the start of the course. MTESOL course participants are expected to attend this Orientation in person in RELC, Singapore. They should thus arrive in Singapore one day before the date of the Orientation.

Research Fellowships

- 9 SEAMEO RELC offers Research Fellowships to the region. The intent of the Research Fellowship is to help develop research capacity in the region and to promote research in areas relevant to the improvement of language education. The application is open throughout the year, and we welcome interested applicants to find out more by writing to us.
