

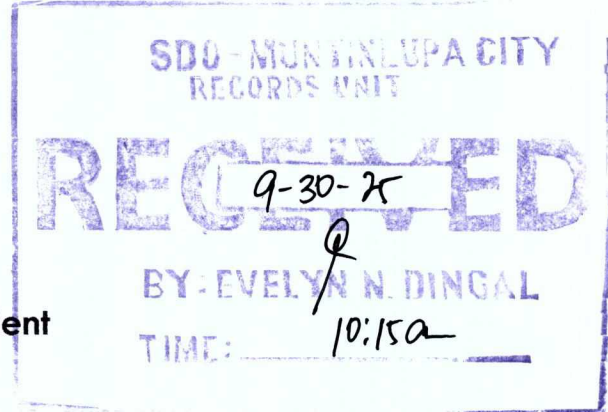

RULES & GUIDELINES

1. DATE/VENUE/EVENT

- Date: November 9, 2025
- Venue: Christ the King Badminton Court, Jaysonville II, Putatan, Muntinlupa City
- Event:
 - Junior HS Girls Singles
 - Junior HS Boys Singles

TOURNAMENT FEE

This is a free tournament sponsored by Senator Angara for **Muntinlupeños only**.

2. ELIGIBILITY

- 2.1 Each participating junior high school, public and private, will have to select 1 female and 1 male players to represent their school.
- 2.2 With limited slots of 25 schools to participate, official list of players with signature of school principal should be submitted at the YASDO Office on or before October 31, 2025. First come first serve basis on the slots.
- 2.3 The organizer and Tournament Manager will declare the official list prior to the start of the game.
- 2.4 All players must play. Changing of line-up is not allowed.
- 2.5 Each player will play on Single Event according to their gender and match made by the Tournament Manager.
- 2.6 Best of three games, with each game played to 15 points.
- 2.7 Knock-out game system will be implemented.
- 2.8 All winners in the semi-finals will automatically receive medals.
- 2.9 There will be five (5) minutes defaulting time.

3. TOURNAMEN FORMAT

KNOCK-OUT SYSTEM.

4. SCORING

Best of three games, with each game played to 15 points.

5. INJURIES

In the event of injury, treatment shall be allowed for five (5) minutes. Muscle cramps is not considered an injury. After which the umpire shall verify with the injured player whether or not he/she can resume play. If for any reason, the injured player cannot continue, the umpire shall declare the opposing player winner by retirement.

6. DEFAULTING OF PLAYERS

All players are required to report to match control 30 minutes before their designated match. Players who are not in their designated courts 5 minutes after the first call shall be defaulted in favour of the opposing player as winner by default.

7. INDEMNITY

The organizers of this tournament and their designated officials as well as Christ the King Badminton Court shall not be held liable on injuries or harm players and spectators may suffer as a result of participating in the said tournament.
