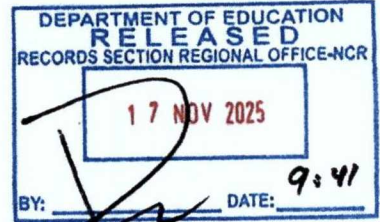

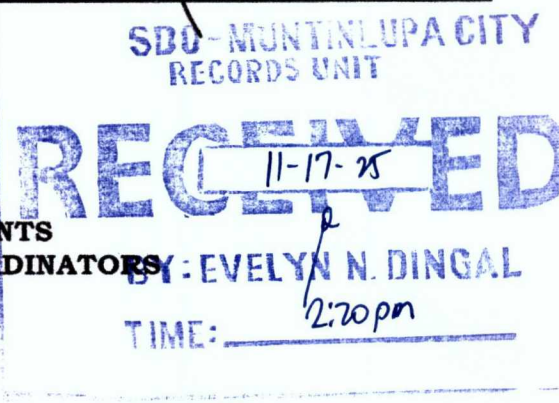

Participants will don judicial robes to enhance the authenticity of the experience.

In view of the above, all public and private schools with active debate clubs or Model United Nations programs, are requested to disseminate the information to eligible public and private high schools within their jurisdictions and facilitate the identification and mobilization of interested student participants.

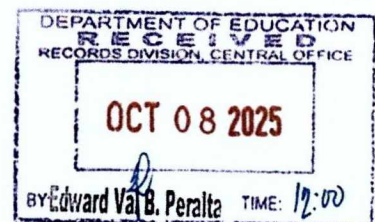
