

Reminders in Preparation for the Fourth Quarter Examination

Test questions shall be teacher-made, based on the competencies covered during the Third quarter.

Schools shall print the test papers following the *Book Old Man Style 11* format. If printing in color enhances the readability and appreciation of the learners, this is encouraged. All related expenses may be charged to available local fund or the MOOE, subject to existing auditing and accounting procedures.

All schools are required to adhere to the synchronized examination schedule. Teachers are likewise reminded to closely monitor their learners and emphasize the importance of taking the examination seriously.

Schools shall submit the list of test proctors per grade level to the Division Testing and Monitoring Team on or before March 9, 2026 for monitoring purposes.

The School Testing Coordinators shall accomplish the Online Quarterly Assessment Dashboard (in Google Sheet format) provided by Dr. Zoren Pepito Gubalane, Senior Education Program Specialist for Monitoring and Evaluation. A hard-copy, duly signed by the School Head and School Testing Coordinator, must be submitted within three (3) days after the conduct of Third Quarter Examination.
