MEMORANDUM

REITERATION ON DENGUE AWARENESS AND PREVENTION

To: Assistant Schools Division Superintendent
Chief Education Supervisor, Curriculum Implementation Division
Chief Education Supervisor, School Governance and Operations Division
Public Elementary and Secondary School Heads/OICs
All Others Concerned

1. In view of reported dengue-associated cases in the community and schools, and relative to Division Unnumbered Memorandum dated February 24, 2025, also known as "Reiteration on Dengue Prevention and Control in Schools", SDO Muntinlupa reiterates the importance of strictly implementing preventive measures to monitor, prevent, and control the spread of dengue, thereby ensuring the safety and well-being of the school populace.
2. All schools are hereby enjoined to observe the following preventive measures:
 - a. *Search and Destroy Mosquito-Breeding Sites*
Conduct regular clean-up drives to eliminate stagnant water and other potential mosquito-breeding areas within and around school premises.
 - b. *Self-Protection Measures*
Encourage all school personnel and learners to wear protective clothing such as long sleeves, jackets, long socks, and pants. The use of mosquito repellents may also be promoted when necessary.
 - c. *Seek Early Consultation*
Educate learners and school personnel on the signs and symptoms of dengue fever. Any individual exhibiting symptoms shall be immediately referred to the nearest health facility for proper medical assessment and treatment.
 - d. *Stay Hydrated*
Ensure adequate water intake among learners and personnel to help maintain normal body temperature and overall health.
 - e. *Collaboration with the Muntinlupa City Health Office*
Coordinate with the City Health Office for space spraying and other vector control interventions, to be conducted only when deemed necessary.
3. All confirmed and suspected dengue cases among learners, teachers, and school personnel shall be promptly reported to the Health and Nutrition Section, c/o Ms. Marie M. Lavin, Division Nurse.


