Rationale and General Description of the Activity

The Philippine International Model United Nations (PHIMUN) is an international Model UN Conference in the Philippines that is open to high school (grades 10-12) and university students (undergraduate to postgraduate). In line with this year's theme, "*Cultivating Diplomatic Resilience: Addressing the Issues of Marginalized Groups and Forgotten Crises in an Era of Deglobalization*", the three-day conference aims to unite young leaders to examine underreported conflicts, systemic inequalities, barriers to humanitarian access, gender-based vulnerabilities, legal challenges to international cooperation, and emerging security risks in an increasingly fragmented global landscape. The event also endeavors to craft solutions for these issues by simulating the procedures of the UN Human Rights Council (UNHRC), the UN General Assembly 6: Legal Committee, the Commission on the Status of Women (CSW), the UN Security Council (UNSC), the International Court of Justice (ICJ), and the ASEAN Emergency Council.

Specific Objectives of the Activity

PHIMUN 2026 aspires to:

- (1) simulate the actual proceedings in the United Nations by conducting their sessions through their major organs, subsidiary bodies, and specialized agencies;
 - (2) to cultivate the minds of future diplomats—engaging them in multinational discussions of global issues leading to consensual resolutions; and lastly,
 - (3) to exhibit the Philippine culture and traditions through numerous endeavors.

I. Conference Proper

A. Description

1. The Conference Proper is the central component of PHIMUN. Delegates are assigned to their respective committees, where they deliberate, negotiate, and debate agenda topics set by the organizers. Each committee is expected to produce one or more resolutions addressing its designated issues.
2. The conference culminates in a Thanksgiving Gala on the final evening, featuring an awards ceremony and an opportunity for participants to commemorate the three days of proceedings.

B. Mechanics

1. Prior to the conference, registrants are assigned a specific Member State and committee. This year, PHIMUN features six committees: the UN Human Rights Council (UNHRC), the UN General Assembly Sixth Committee (Legal), the Commission on the Status of Women (CSW), the UN Security Council (UNSC), the International Court of Justice (ICJ), and the ASEAN Emergency Council.
 2. Each delegate is required to submit a position paper before the conference. This paper should reflect the assigned Member State's official stance and proposed solutions, which may later inform draft resolutions during committee sessions.
 3. During committee sessions, delegates act as diplomats representing their assigned Member State in the United Nations and must declare themselves either "present" or "present and voting" during roll call.
 4. Delegates are expected to deliver speeches, participate in setting the agenda, and engage actively in both moderated and unmoderated caucuses.
 5. By the end of the conference, committees should produce draft resolutions that address the agenda topic and reflect both Member State positions and the mandate of the assigned committee.
 6. Delegates will vote on draft resolutions. Those that pass will be presented during a plenary session attended by all committees.
 7. Delegates who demonstrate exceptional participation, diplomacy, subject mastery, and adherence to procedure will be recognized by the Dais through the Best Delegate and Honorable Mention awards.
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C. Awards

1. Best Position Paper — Awarded to delegates who submit outstanding position papers that accurately represent their nation's stance and present realistic, well-developed solutions. Evaluation criteria are as follows:
 - a. Content and Development: Demonstrates strong analytical ability and uses relevant evidence. — 60%
 - b. Organization: Presents a clear, firm, and well-defined position. — 20%
 - c. Structure: Logical flow and clarity of presentation. — 15%
 - Format: Adherence to standards of grammar, usage, punctuation, and spelling. — 5%
2. Best Delegate — Presented to one delegate per committee in recognition of outstanding performance throughout committee sessions.
3. Honorable Mention — Presented to two delegates per committee who have also demonstrated exemplary performance. Selection for Best Delegate and Honorable Mention will be based on the following considerations:
 - a. Demonstrated expertise on the agenda, including background knowledge and committee developments.
 - b. Clear understanding of the assigned country's foreign policy and its application to committee actions (not applicable to ICJ delegates).
 - c. Active participation in discussions and debates.
 - d. Strong diplomatic conduct and public speaking skills.
 - e. Significant contribution to the drafting of resolutions.
 - f. Command of the Rules of Procedure.
4. Best Group Delegation — Awarded to the delegation from a single school or university that demonstrates the strongest collective performance throughout the conference.
 - a. Votes earned by each delegation are totaled and divided by the product of the number of committees represented and the number of sessions (e.g., 5 committees × 8 sessions = 40 opportunities for recognition).
 - b. Delegates from the same institution who meet the Best Delegate criteria across committees contribute to their delegation's standing.
 - c. The institution represented by the winning delegation will be formally recognized.

II. Humanitarian Forum

A. Description

1. The Humanitarian Forum (SDG Forum) is among the opening events of PHIMUN. Delegates will hear from a distinguished speaker recognized for their contributions to diplomacy, foreign service, or international development.
2. The session aims to raise awareness of careers in diplomacy and foreign service, particularly for delegates considering these paths. The speaker will also address

international issues aligned with the conference theme and encourage delegates to develop solutions through debate and resolution-making.

3. The forum will conclude with an open question-and-answer segment, allowing delegates to share insights and engage directly with the speaker.

III. PHIMUN Gala and Cultural Night

A. Description

1. The PHIMUN Gala and Cultural Night serves as the official closing event of the conference. Delegates will attend a formal diplomatic dinner featuring cultural performances and keynote addresses.
2. Important announcements, including session-related reminders and house rules, may also be delivered during the program.
3. Delegates are encouraged to wear the national attire of their assigned countries as a celebration of cultural diversity and international camaraderie.


