Greetings!

We are a team from the College of Allied Medical Professions, University of the Philippines Manila (UP CAMP) currently conducting research entitled "Ethnogeographic variations in physical function among Filipino and Australian children: a cross-sectional observational study under the Australia-Philippines 1000 Norms Project (Aus-Phil 1000 Norms Project)." The purpose of the Aus-Phil 1000 Norms Project is to investigate normal variation in the healthy human population. The study involves collecting basic physical and health-related information from 300 healthy children aged from 3 to 17 years.

We hope to recruit healthy children and youth from schools/childcare centers around your city. Participants will perform different activities that will look at how the body moves and works (e.g. walking, jumping, using hands, etc.). Participants and their parents/care providers will also complete some questionnaires. Data collection will last approximately 2 hours and will be done at the University of the Philippines - Manila at an agreed upon schedule. Participation is voluntary and only those who indicated their interest to join will be contacted by the research team. Data gathered will be made available only to the researchers of the study. It will be kept private and confidential by securing the data in a passcode protected computer drive accessible only to the researchers and possibly a research assistant.

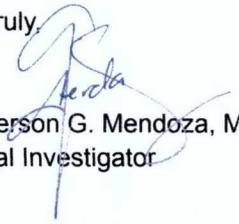
