



**Regional Workshop for the Science High Schools, STEs and SSES
Implementing Schools for Curriculum, Assessment and Operations For
Improved Learning Outcomes**

1. In line with the DepEd NCR's continuing commitment to improving learning outcomes in Science, Technology, Engineering, and Mathematics (STEM), and consistent with national education reform directions emphasizing curriculum coherence, data-driven decision-making, and strengthened governance of science programs, this Office through the Curriculum Learning and Management Division (CLMD), shall conduct the **abovecaptioned activity** on **February 11 - 13, 2026** at **Makati Palace Hotel, Makati City**.
2. This regional activity aims to provide a structured platform for harmonization, validation, and capacity-building among Science High Schools, Science, Technology and Engineering (STE) Program implementing schools, and Special Science Elementary School (SSES) implementing schools across the National Capital Region.
3. Specifically, the workshop seeks to accomplish the following objectives:
 1. Draft a harmonized curriculum paper for Grades 7-10 covering Enhanced Science, Enhanced Mathematics, Science and Mathematics Add-on Subjects, Research, and Creative Technologies for DepEd NCR Science High Schools, ensuring coherence, vertical alignment, and responsiveness to learner needs;
 2. Conduct data validation for STE and SSES implementing schools in NCR, focusing on learner performance, participation, and outcomes, as inputs to evidence-based planning and targeted interventions for improved learning outcomes, leading towards the STE and SSES scorecard;
 3. Craft operational guidelines for Legislated and Science High Schools in NCR, covering curriculum implementation, assessment practices, and program operations, to guide implementation beginning School Year 2026-2027 onwards; and
 4. Develop monitoring tools for NCR science programs, to support systematic monitoring, evaluation, and continuous improvement of Science High School, STE, and SSES implementation starting School Year 2026-2027.

7. Expenses relative to the conduct of the activity such as board and lodging, training kits and other miscellaneous expenses shall be charged to **OSCC-NCR-25-04573**, while travel expenses of the participants shall be charged to MOOE or other local funds, subject to usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
