1. Relative to Regional Memorandum No. 107, s. 2026, titled *2026 Regional Festival of Talents (RFoT)* with the theme, **“Embracing Change, Redefining Excellence,”** this Office hereby announces the official delegation of SDO Muntinlupa to the said activity on February 24–26, 2026, at Pasay City.
2. The delegation shall be composed of qualified learners, coaches/trainers, principals, and designated SDO officials who are authorized to participate, supervise, and provide technical assistance during the conduct of the regional competitions.
3. Each participating learner-qualifier from this Division, listed as a Division winner, shall pay a registration fee of **Four Hundred Pesos (Php 400.00)**. This fee shall be charged against the school MOOE/Local/SEF/Canteen fund, subject to the existing government accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
4. Transportation, meals, and other allowable expenses for EPSs, Trainers, and participants shall be covered by division/school/local funds (MOOE, school Funds, and other available funds), including expenses related to the contest, in accordance with standard accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
5. Participants and coaches/trainers are advised to secure their Authority to Travel and submit a signed copy to their respective Education Program Supervisor.
6. Participation of division officials and teachers in the activities conducted during weekends or holidays shall entitle them to a Compensatory Overtime Credit (COC) pursuant to DepEd Order No. 53, s. 2023, and CSC-DBM Joint Circular No.2, s. 2004 and Vacation Service Credits for teachers in accordance with DepEd Order No. 13, s. 2004, subject to existing rules and regulations.



2026 REGIONAL FESTIVAL OF TALENTS (RFOT)

1. The Department of Education-National Capital Region through the Curriculum and Learning Management Division will hold the above-captioned activity with the theme "**Embracing Change, Redefining Excellence**" from February 24 to 26, 2026, hosted by Schools Division Office of Pasay City.
2. RFOT is an annual activity organized by DepEd which aims to:
 - a. Provide meaningful learning opportunities in different programs through showcasing of acquired knowledge;
 - b. Guide the learners in choosing relevant career paths related to the four curriculum exits-higher education, middle-level skills development, entrepreneurship, and employment, as outlined in the Enhanced K to 12 Basic Education Program; and
 - c. Serves as a culminating activity for assessing learning mastery and skill development in accordance with learning standards.
3. The different contests of the 2026 RFOT shall reflect inclusive, authentic and interdisciplinary approaches to learning. These shall challenge learners to be creative, innovative and collaborative in demonstrating multiple intelligences and essential 21st Century skills for success in a dynamic, interconnected, and future ready world.

Note: Bench Cheer is a newly proposed contest for inclusion in the Regional Festival of Talents (RFOT), to be implemented in coordination with PhilHealth.

The final list of events, as well as the number of participants and entries to the National Festival of Talents (NFOT) shall depend on the Memorandum to be issued by the Central Office.

5. Eligible participants for the Regional Festival of Talents (RFOT) shall be endorsed by the Schools Division Office (SDO). A letter of endorsement must be submitted to the Curriculum and Learning Management Division on or before February 13, 2026. Participation in the 2026 RFOT is voluntary and shall not, in any way, affect the time-on-task of teachers, as the target learning standards and competencies for this activity are already embedded in teachers' actual classroom teaching and assessment processes.

6. Each participating learner-qualifiers, from both public and private schools listed as Division winners shall pay a registration fee of **Four Hundred Pesos (Php 400.00)**. This fee shall be charged against school MOOE/Local/SEF/Canteen fund, subject to the existing government accounting and auditing rules and regulations.

7. The registration fee is intended for the honorarium of judges, and other related expenses, while the board and lodging of RO focal persons/TWGs, medals, trophies and AM snacks and lunch for students, coaches, and technical working group (TWG) for three (3) days and other related expenses shall be shouldered by the host division and LGU. Furthermore, expenses related to travel and other pertinent costs incurred by the RTWG, supervisors, coaches and contestants shall be charged against local funds subject to the existing accounting and auditing rules and regulations.

8. Registration fees shall be paid through the DepEd-NCR account with the following details:



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GUIDELINES ON PROTEST AND APPEAL

1. In case of protest, the concerned division shall send the formal letter of complaint signed by the coach, division focal in RFOT and Schools Division Superintendent within 3 days after the announcement of winners. The complaint shall be resolved within five (5) days from receipt hereof.

In addition, the letter of protest shall be accompanied by affidavit/s of witnesses and/or pieces of evidence in support thereof. Failure to comply to the aforementioned shall not be given due course.

2. The communication shall be addressed to the organizers of RFOT 2026 for proper review of the same.
3. The contested category shall be reviewed and decided upon by the judges and must be immediately communicated to the team/group concerned.
4. In case of appeal, a committee on appeals shall review the decision made by the judges. The composition of the committee are as follows:
 - Regional Focal Persons – RFOT 2026
 - Chief (CLMD)
 - Expert Members (Technical Committee)
 - Legal Unit Chief/lawyer
5. **The decision of the Board shall be final and irrevocable.**
