

- **Government Agencies:** Department of Education (DepEd), Technical Education and Skills Development Authority (TESDA), and Department of Labor and Employment (DOLE).
- **Private & International Partners:** Unified TVET of the Philippines, Inc., Hytec Power Inc., and the Colombo Plan Staff College (CPSC).

The TWG is mandated to perform a formal, systematic review of school-level programs within DepEd. This initiative aims to:

- **Ensure Regulatory Compliance:** Align programs with existing national laws and educational policies.
- **Promote Program Synergy:** Foster convergence between curricular and extracurricular activities.
- **Enhance Instructional Coherence:** Guarantee that student instruction remains relevant to current industry needs.
- **Streamline Career Pathways:** Improve student progression through key stages and into post-secondary opportunities, including college, advanced TVET, and the workforce.
- **Optimize Resource Management:** Provide data-driven insights for the strategic allocation of manpower, learning tools, and equipment starting in FY 2026.
- **Establish Standards:** Benchmark existing DepEd programs against best practices.


