

The comeback of **WATER DEXTERITY & More...** has the following particulars for the guidance and strict compliance to ensure organization and safety of everyone:

- PARTICIPANTS** : Registered STARS, JUNIORS, SENIORS, CADETS and TROOP LEADERS who are physically fit as certified by a physician and/or school nurse; girls must have Parents/Guardians Consent
- ARRIVAL and REGISTRATION** : beginning at 7:00 o'clock in the morning
- THINGS to BRING** : Food provision and drinking water
Extra Clothes for change
Trash/Litter Bags (Littering in the area is strictly prohibited)
First-aid kits for every school or troop
GSP I.D
- DRESSCODE** : Preferably complete and correct Official or outdoor uniform
During travel and Opening Program and other activities
- Proper swimming attire (bathing suit, rash guard, short without button/s)

EVENT'S FEE : Troop Leaders – P150.00; Girls - P250.00

This being official activity, Girl Scouting Funds, Local Funds, MOOE/SEF and other sources may be used subject to standard accounting and auditing procedures.

RECOGNITION : Certificates for ALL plus 2 badges for the Girls who complete the required activities.

Reservation with List of Participants will be accepted until February 24, 2026.

For the GSP Coordinators and Troop Leaders please orient our Girls to observe the following:

- Avoid littering the place (bring litter bags)
- Buddy system at all times;
- Wearing GSP ID at all times;
- Listen very well to instructions and announcements;
- Deeping in the pool is allowed only at the specific time per cluster;
- Memorize by heart the GS Promise and Law and A Girl Scout Prayer.

We trust that your favorable response for the maximum participation of our Troops will be accorded as this project.
