Greetings of peace!

Greetings of peace! Governometrics Management Consultancy Services (Governometrics for brevity) is a privately owned consulting business established in October 2020 but has been operating for nearly five years now since March 2021. It originally served human development objective drawing from knowledge base(s) of Governometrics and/or development centered disciplines in order to provide solutions for, summarily, policy action points as core service offering for target clientele. It is currently positioned as consulting partner for industry, education and development offering original, hybrid, unique and bespoke solutions for its pioneering and newest governorship and significance advisory services, as well as its continuing but now advancements-centered services for knowledge formation, evaluation studies, and project based initiatives couched in knowhow bases of Governometrics and Humanity.

Governometrics annually holds the Global Forum for Humanity (GFH) as its core foundation term activity. It organized the GFH in collaboration with its overseas partners in the Asia Pacific region for the first two years (2023-2024) using blended modality of participation and engagement, and with domestic program objective presented to its general audience from at least 50 nations using popular social media platforms on the third year (2025). For this year, the GFH takes a sharp 180 degree turn



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toward addressing select domestic concerns of the Philippine nation in four target areas (FTAs): education reforms (i.e., literacy and school outcomes gap), poverty alleviation (i.e., social protection), disaster and climate education action, and economic development as part of the roll out plan of the Integrated Service Initiative Program (I.S.I.P.) by Governometrics.

The instrumental goal of I.S.I.P. is to organize and carry out serious partnership initiatives between Governometrics and major stakeholders, with whom its owner has had forged collaborative work history, in order to formulate unique but sound intervention and deliver critical services at subsectoral level in the short run (2026-2028) as well as to explore their rerouting for (inter)national integration (discourse) in the medium term (2028-2033). The higher and end goal for I.S.I.P. shall be discussed during the forum proper of the GFH.

For this year, given said thrusts, the 4th Global Forum for Humanity shall formally hold its Philippine Open for the launch of I.S.I.P. bearing the theme, "HUMANITY: GOVERNORS OF LIGHT AND DEEDS (Breakdowns, Breakpoints, Breakthroughs, Breakforths)". For the education sector, the session is scheduled on 8 April 2026, Wednesday, from 8:30 AM to 5:30 PM at Brentwood Suites in Quezon City, Philippines. It is expected to be participated by invited and registering education, social protection and anti-poverty reform advocates in the Philippines.

I specifically identified your office as major stakeholder in view of DepEd's interest on education reform discourses. Beyond this perspective, the sites of data collection for Humanity Report include your region/province/municipality. Your office may also be interested to benchmark experiences with forum speakers. Take this opportunity for your delegate(s) to draft office action plan alone or benefit in spending time discoursing and validating claims with colleagues and work peers. Sessions for question and answer (Q&A) and general open forum are opened for your delegate(s) engagement. You may as well explore possibilities for program partnership with Governometrics to achieve the ends of localization of education reforms for targeted 4Ps community clusters. For this matter, I am reserving 10 seats free of charge; *one seat each* for the first 10 DepEd SDOs that shall confirm participation and commit to send at least one contingent.

The contingent shall be given a certificate of participation during the awarding ceremonies. Food and registration fee are basically covered.

Lastly, your office may be interested to send presenters for the call for papers. The summary details of preparation are detailed in the poster attached this correspondence. All presenters whose works are found fit to the conference theme shall be requested to prepare video recording of presentation, which shall be shown for one full day, as part of the conference proceedings. But authors who submitted papers adjudged as outstanding works are required to do live presentation and receive certificate of merit.

Should there be an interest or need to send additional contingents for an institutional delegation to attend the two day forum, Governometrics charges for a fee for each seat in excess of the reserved ones. The discounted rates for external participants are as follows:

- PhP 2,000/pax for full day session on education reform advocacy, or full session for Day 2



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- PhP 3,750/pax for 2 day sessions (Day 1: education reform advocacy, Day 2: the Governors of Light and Deeds: Foundational Lecture and Case Presentations on Creative Transformation of Systems and Futures).

General fee inclusions are for the following services: registration, food (AM/PM snacks and lunch, free drinks), and basic forum kit (program, pen, notepad). Governometrics knowledge products to be made available during the forum are exclusions. As for paper presenters, they shall receive certificate of presentation and certificate of publication in conference proceedings of their submitted works. If papers from your organized delegation are accepted, your office research and publications committee members are automatically included in the editorial board as either local or special issue editorial board members.

This is to advise as well your office that Governometrics has never initiated applying for accreditation with any state office in order to avail certification services of its pioneering service programs. This is to provide ready and candid response to inquiries we received from a number of DepEd SDOs in relation to disseminated invites of our forum/conference launches in CYs 2022-2024. However, I am pleased to inform you that Governometrics is accredited by PhilGEPS for consulting projects (c. 2022), registered with ISSN for periodical or series publications (c. 2021), accredited member of UN network for Disaster and Climate action called WIN (c. 2022) and passed the accreditation requirement for DepEd Quality Circle for special projects on textbook and materials development (via yours truly) (c. 2009-2010s), among other earned certifications domestically and overseas. 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The report contains one minor observation of profound implications for consideration of both learners and educators which is highlighted in this advisory. The subject centers on the difference it could make on lives and institutions in interpreting data if one would only listen to the lived human experiences and imparted human expressions, even as briefly articulated, behind the numerics. It was incidentally uncovered by Governometrics while gauging the valuation of Filipinos for political leaders, especially in relation to their performance in state offices, as part of the originally planned chapter of the report.

For the first two completed fieldworks of GPS, voluntary respondents were asked to provide performance rating for state leaders of the country, from the highest level, the Philippine President, down to his local government officials, the barangay council members. All of the GPS respondents provided the numerical ratings in accordance with the requirement of the question.

By and large this particular exercise treats each Filipino's performance rating as voting process. It means that each responding Filipino is treated as standalone voter as if exercising an autonomous political role in responding to the question. If so, as regards the disclosed responses, the role of the reporting adviser must be able to treat ratings of leaders independent of one another, initially. Ratings can therefore be treated as unique information. They can be processed into figures and analyzable data, and can be compared with one another to produce observations and findings. This is the convention.

In being asked about their knowledge of the functions and roles of these leaders, GPS respondents provided sincere and

For about five years now, since its establishment in 2020 and commencement of operations in 2021, Governometrics Management Consultancy Services has been engaged in series of inhouse studies and projects. They used to be publicly inaccessible or made for exclusive use of paying and free service clients but not anymore starting this year, CY 2026! It is because they bear its advocacies for human significance and systems futures. These advocacies are too critical to be left for discussion in view of the highly overlooked essence of and eroding valuation toward humanity and human life in general in favor of the more pragmatic and material considerations of the world on how people and institutions are shaped to conduct its affairs.

In February 2025, Governometrics embarked on initiating the conduct of evaluative studies on the subject under its banner program, Governometrics Pivotal Services or GPS. In the series of completed investigations, the Philippines had been identified as preliminary site of observation. The resulting report from yearlong progressive investigations shall finally be released in the series of publications tailored cut toward the needs of offices, sectors and professions in CY 2026. The issue is called, **The Humanity Report**, and its pilot release is entitled, **The First Gaze at Human Significance** (Philippine Case Study). Volume I shall underscore the implications of report findings for the education sector which is scheduled as discussion opener in the Global Forum for Humanity, the Philippines Open on 8-9 April 2026 at Brentwood Suites in Quezon City.

For about five years now, since its establishment in 2020 and

honest responses. They answered to the best of their knowledge, which worked as well to the best interest of GPS. Three sets of responses, technically called response types, emerged from the process. In the first type, no response was given to items of which they lacked (even partial) understanding or knowledge. In the second, GPS also received perceptive responses when respondents identified these functions and roles in terms of what they observed from their social environment, read from some sources, and recalled from life experiences. The third set was informed: to mean, derived from solid knowledge base that came from valid and reliable sources of information. All of the responses can still be considered rational and acceptable, regardless of their category set, and therefore, subject, supposedly, to the rules of conventional analytics for discrete data and information.

But in examining the content of responses, the kingdom truth of convention starts collapsing. Focusing solely on the "recurrent" understanding of these respondents of the functions and roles speaks volume already. Consider for instance that the Philippine President was understood to be the father of the nation who should look after the welfare of his people. Although the statement is contentious and "motherhood" type, the underlying view here is that he does not compete in authority with any one but duty bound to exercise it to obtain what is good for the nation. On the other hand, when asked about the duties and roles of Senators and Congressmen, the typical response is "as lawmakers". Others meant that these leaders formulate laws to address the concerns of the country. But in order to advance the claim, respondents must be aware that leaders occupy offices that respond to peculiar needs of the nation.

In short, GPS unearthed the institutional perspective of Filipinos that underpins the value assigned to performance ratings of political leaders (and to some other items as well).

Its weight could render futile the conventional treatment of performance ratings to be mutually exclusive.

Operationally and analytically, this perspective adds fresh understanding of ground realities as it implies two crucial points. One, the ratings of the President and lawmakers are naturally inclusive because, albeit occupying different offices, they belong to one government system that connects these offices. So what? If one obtains the cross tabulation of leaders' performance ratings wherein responses of select respondent segments deter or cancel off each other's effects, following conventional methodology, the results tilt toward the interpretation that naturally but subliminally promotes divisiveness when they need not be. Recommendations utilizing the results become less potent and useful. Second, and the reason behind the first point is that Filipinos possess the capacity to provide institutionalist response, if not imply that their individual responses stemmed from their understanding of how a government system works.

In view of the above information, Governometrics saw that computational convention of performance ratings could possibly, if not naturally, sideline the unsung assumption and reality that rational respondents, no matter their ordinariness and rank in society, may advance responses with both depth and contexts. It is crucial to point out that institutionalist responses do not conform to conventional add, minus, average and rank metrics. Political discussion is really a complex matter but when taken from respondents' standpoints, despite having unstable focus or changing foci, is not exempt from possessing stable referential locus.

Learners and educators are shown here that a careful treatment of information could go a long way in producing data and rectifying method, application and knowledge formation. This is an illustrative case on where

Governometrics is anchoring its campaign for Humanity and Systems Futures and Significance. Not in relevance, quality, excellence or other goals on the losing ground to insignificance every time crisis, uncertainty or disruption happens overtime.

If we want to create a difference that matters first and that multiplies next, we need to have and possess a renewed set of eyes and hands, which goes hand in hand with renewed mind, soul and spirit. Otherwise, one shall find in the same zone and cycle of circumstances every time concerns arise.

The beauty in factoring human and systems significance in any initiative, in this regard, is that people from any walk of life would count in. It makes it easier to claim that Filipinos can finally be recognized as people who possess working knowledge, little to immense, of their governmental systems, regardless of their activity or passivity in their exercise of participation in nation building activities. Knowledge is not exclusively attributed to the educated, learned, well connected, powerful, or the elite.

More importantly, respondents do not face the reign of dictatorship of questions and biases that shape the assumption(s) underpinning these questions. If we could hear each respondent well, even without knowing them personally, we can then start treating people on a sacred ground. And if this is where humanity and systems are situated, then we are duty bound to produce viable, useful and real helpful metrics capable of hosting personal and institutional dimensions of responses. In this manner, data, knowledge and initiatives can meet people where they are and truly stand rather than accept their traditional role as recipients of imposed understanding of a segment of society on what they actually knew and said but did not in actuality.

In essence, we are generally saying that information, data

and knowledge should be hosted on a sacred ground of development and utilization as well. This is how a future that connects to the futures that we desire to matter and multiply is initiated for creation.

Indeed, what we have found out as previously discussed was simply a minor observation of a technical report derived from an accidental gaze on a situation awaiting unearthing and exploration. Yet, we all saw the value for transformation of initiatives when we just choose to host them on a sacred ground, of development and utilization. We all saw the generation of new ways of understanding situations; of reading and learning about the profound implications of ruptured knowledge not for its own sake at all but - farther than its reach or ahead of the speed of mind to dismiss uncommonness - for the lives of those we intend to find, love and serve, which may or may not be similarly situated.

Yes, we can choose to risk taking a step further for such a noble cause.

In its interim phase of operations, 2026-2028, Governometrics aims to meet educators - owners, managers, advocates and end users, exactly where their needs are parked and probably intensifying so that everyone involved can unite together to amplify the difference sowed in the past to matter further and multiply in greater fold in the (near) future. Education reforms are one target area of its intervention through Integrated Service Initiatives Program (I.S.I.P.). Taking off from its program forerunners such as A.C.U.M.E.N., Ex.C.E.L.L. Phils. and G.O.L.D., I.S.I.P. has been designed to provide bold, aggressive but qualified move to address priority reform areas in education, especially the perennial plague of literacy and learning outcome gaps.

Parallel to the foregoing is what this advisory note has just

shown and demonstrated as case problem naturally occurring in knowledge bases but was not left without a response to be made on the matter, which in the case of Governometrics shall debut brief discussions on via the Humanity Report, to be publicly discussed during the Global Forum for Humanity, the Philippine Open, Day 1 for educators and Day 2 for knowhow advocates and other interested parties.

The literacy and learning outcome gaps as education reform priority area is related to the observation highlighted in this advisory note. The latter is actually a case of functional literacy issue, in its advanced state, that stemmed from our preconceptions about humanity and thought process of individuals or their group which blindsides our application of our derived knowledge about them.

We can also appreciate the situation as an allusion. The GPS respondents with voice lacking volume to explain what they know about state offices are similarly situated with learners with literacy issues. Both know something on the same subject but have functional ineffectiveness in executing knowledge not for the lack of ability to produce outcomes but for being unable to express, articulate and therefore enact it because of the inexistence of measures (method, system or initiatives) to support such conventionally considered as either an "anomaly" or a "constancy".

But we previously saw that when surface, intermediate, intervening, and underlying biases and concerns are differentiated, the true and critical observations do reveal and expose themselves upfront. Reality is clearly magnified. We can then investigate. Responses can then be provided.

Given the right knowhow bases, the weight of transformation

that can be effected and delivered even at the foundational level of reform intervention lights up the mind. And is good for the soul. In unity with the spirit. Supportive of the eyes and hands.

That is just a starter launch, because the other way of reading the matter in this advisory note is that serious but meaningful work awaits to prepare the Filipinos in understanding better everyone's duties and roles in governing this nation, within and beyond the notion of citizenship.

We only need to unite, discuss and take action. *Together!*
Under the banner of Light of the God that we know.
