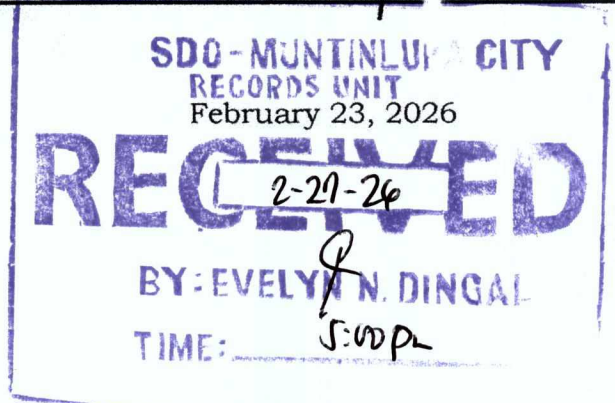
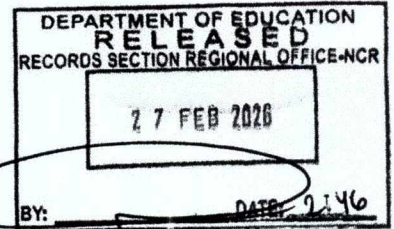

DEPED TV LAUNCH THROUGH KNOWLEDGE CHANNEL FOUNDATION, INC. (KCFI)-SOLAR LEARNING PARTNERSHIP

1. Pursuant to Unnumbered Memorandum dated December 29, 2025 from Secretary Sonny Angara, all Schools Division Offices with access to DepEd TV, powered by Knowledge Channel Foundation Inc. (KCFI) in partnership with Solar Learning, shall integrate broadcast-based, curriculum-aligned programs into instruction, as appropriate to the learning competencies and teaching plans, to strengthen lesson delivery and support learners in mastering key skills.
2. The divisions and schools shall adopt DepEd TV as part of their learning continuity measures to minimize learning loss and sustain structured learning engagements at home particularly during the periods of class suspension whether due to extreme heat, heavy rainfall, flooding, or other disruptions.
3. DepEd TV programs may be accessed through Digital Free TV, Cable TV and Direct-to-Home (DTH) Satellite as indicated in the attached Memorandum.

All schools division offices (SDOs) with access to DepEd TV, powered by Knowledge Channel Foundation, Inc. (KCFI) in partnership with Solar Learning, shall integrate broadcast-based, curriculum-aligned programs into instruction, as appropriate to the learning competencies and teaching plans, to strengthen lesson delivery and support learners in mastering key skills. Teachers may use these video resources to enrich instruction and reinforce lessons where they best complement existing strategies.

During periods of class suspension—whether due to extreme heat, heavy rainfall, flooding, or other disruptions—SDOs and schools shall adopt DepEd TV as part of their learning continuity measures to minimize learning loss and sustain structured learning engagements at home. Teachers shall provide viewing guidance or related activities to ensure learners can meaningfully engage with the assigned content.

DepEd TV programs may be accessed through **Digital Free TV, Cable TV, and Direct-to-Home (DTH) Satellite**, as follows:

1. Digital Free TV

DepEd TV is available on **BEAM Channel 31** and **SBN Channel 21**. Viewers may access these channels by scanning the following digital TV boxes:

- ABS-CBN TV Plus
- EasyTV
- SulitTV
- GMA Affordabox

2. Cable TV

DepEd TV may be viewed through the following cable providers:

- SkyCable (NCR) – Channel 5
- SkyTV (Provincial) – Channel 32
- Cablelink (NCR) – Channel 3
- PCTA – PCTA Member Cable Operators Nationwide

3. Direct-to-Home (DTH) Satellite

DepEd TV may also be accessed through the following satellite providers:

- Signal – Channel 146
- Satlite – Channel 182
