

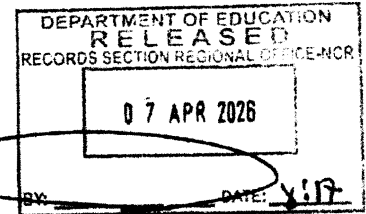

2026 NATIONAL SCHOOLS PRESS CONFERENCE (NSPC)

- This is in reference to DepEd Memorandum no. 021 s. 2026 dated March 19, 2026 entitled: “**2026 National Schools Press Conference (NSPC)**”, with the theme **Mapanuri, Mapanindigan, at Mapanagutang Pamamahayag (Critical, Principled, and Accountable Journalism)**, to be held on April 13 – 17, 2026 (exclusive of travel time) within Ormoc City.

 Enclosure 3: NSPC Reminders
- The NCR delegates shall be billeted at **Liloan National High School**, Barangay Liloan, Ormoc City, Leyte.
- All national qualifiers are enjoined to submit their parents permit on or before April 13, 2026.
- NCR participants joining the event are encouraged to wear the approved NSPC advocacy shirt specially during parade, t-shirt uniforms may be charged against local funds and other available funds, subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
- Travel expenses, per diem and other incidental expenses of the following NSPC participants shall be charged against downloaded funds, local funds and other available funds, subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.

- NSPC qualifiers and Outstanding Campus Journalists	- Regional NSPC delegates - Division NSPC participants - NCR NSPC qualifiers coaches - Other division identified participants - School paper advisers of the overall Top 5 Best School Publication, per medium, per level

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7. School paper advisers of winning publications per medium and level, are enjoined to participate in the preparation and management of the NCR booth as part of the school paper exhibit. Booths shall be manned at all times by the delegated officer of the Regional School Paper Advisers Association. Their transportation and other related expenses may be charged against MOOE/local/regional/special education funds or school campus journalism funds, subject to existing accounting and auditing rules and regulations.

8. Consequently, the participation of regional and division officials to the aforesaid activity falling on a holiday or a weekend entitles them to a one and a half day (1.5) compensatory overtime credit (COC per day, pursuant to DepEd Order No. 53, s. 2003 and CSC and DBM Joint circular No. 2 s. 2004. Likewise, the participation of teachers in the mentioned activity falling on a weekend or holiday shall likewise be eligible for service credit pursuant to DO 53 s. 2023, "Updated Guidelines on Granting Vacation Service Credits to Teachers.", subject to existing DepEd rules and regulations.
