**CONDUCT OF PROJECT SHAPE 3.0 (SCHOOL HEADS APPRENTICESHIP TOWARD
PRIMING AND EMPOWERMENT) FOR POTENTIAL SCHOOL LEADERS**

1. In line with the commitment of this Office to foster a culture of excellence and ensure the continuous professional growth of human resources as stipulated in Siklab DUNONG, this Office announces the conduct of Project SHAPE 3 on May 4-6, 2026, at the SDO Student Center.
2. Project SHAPE 3 is a specialized simulation-based assessment designed to identify and refine the leadership competencies of aspiring school heads. By placing candidates in controlled, high-stakes environments, the program seeks to bridge the gap between theoretical pedagogical knowledge and the practical, multifaceted demands of school management.
3. The three-day intensive assessment will utilize an Assessment Center (AC) approach, featuring the following competency-based exercises:
 - **Administrative In-Basket Simulation:** Participants will assume the role of an incumbent school head tasked with managing a complex workload within a strict duration. This involves analyzing and resolving a variety of urgent memoranda, financial reports, and community concerns to evaluate their ability to prioritize tasks and make sound administrative decisions.
 - **Interactive Role-Play Scenario:** This exercise replicates critical interpersonal challenges, such as mediating disputes with difficult stakeholders or coaching underperforming subordinates. Candidates must demonstrate high levels of emotional intelligence, negotiation prowess, and conflict-resolution skills.
 - **Leaderless Group Discussion (LGD):** Candidates will be presented with a systemic educational issue to solve as a collective, without a designated chairperson. This allows the assessment team to observe natural leadership emergence, collaborative spirit, and the ability to influence and communicate effectively within a peer group.

- **Behavioral Competency Interview:** A structured, evidence-based dialogue focusing on the candidate's professional history and leadership philosophy. The interview assesses alignment with the Department's core values and the specific managerial standards required for effective school governance.
- **Strategic Planning and Resource Management Exercise:** An evaluative task requiring the formulation of a comprehensive School Improvement Plan (SIP) or project proposal. This measures the candidate's capacity for long-term visioning, resource optimization, and logical goal-setting.


- Day 1 (May 4): Opening Program, In-Basket Simulation, and Planning Exercise.
