2. Private Schools that intend to deviate from the models stipulated	Write to Regional Officer (RO) for approval
3. Private Schools that will adopt the Three-Term Calendar for the coming SY	Signify its alignment and submit their School Calendar to SDO
4. Private Schools implementing Strengthen Senior HS curriculum	Submit to SDO-Curriculum Implementation Division (CID) the Class Programs for Grades 11 & 12
5. Private Schools which have crafted their Implementation Plans	May now submit their documents until five days before the opening of classes

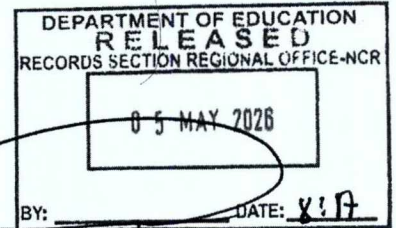

**SY 2026-2027 CURRICULUM AND LEARNING DELIVERY IMPLEMENTATION
OF PRIVATE BASIC EDUCATION INSTITUTIONS**

1. Pursuant to the Department's recent policy issuances namely:
 - a) DepEd Memorandum No. 024 s. 2026 - Clarifying the Flexibility of Private Schools to Adopt Learning and Training Delivery Modalities Amid the National Energy Emergency;
 - b) DepEd Order No. 009, s. 2026 - Guidelines on the Implementation of the Three-Term School Calendar in Basic Education; and
 - c) DepEd Memorandum No. 12, s. 2026 - Full Implementation of the Strengthened Senior High School Curriculum in School Year 2026-2027,

this Office will gather information among private schools that will align their curricular implementation with these policies starting School Year 2026-2027.

2. All private schools that will shift to blended learning modalities based on the models provided in DM 024 s. 2026, should only write to their respective Schools Division Office (SDO) on the planned change in delivery modality and include the modified class program and other operational plans to ensure attainment of required learning standards.

However, schools that intend to deviate from the models stipulated in the Memorandum, must inform the Regional Office as prior approval from the Office is required.

3. Likewise, schools that will adopt the Three-Term Calendar, presented in DO 009 s.2026 for the coming SY, are likewise directed to signify its alignment and submit their School Calendar to the SDO.

The School Governance and Operations Division (SGOD) through the Private Schools Focal Person shall submit a summary report to this Office relative to the learning delivery modalities and reviewed School Calendar of their private schools.



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4. Lastly, in relation to the implementation of the Strengthened Senior High School curriculum for both the public and private school systems, all private schools shall submit to the SDOs through the Curriculum and Implementation Division (CID) the Class Programs for Grades 11 and 12 for the academic and/or TechPro Tracks they will offer. The Class Programs should contain the placement of Core, Elective subjects and Specializations including the required number of hours per subject in each term/semester for each grade level.

Particular attention should be made on the offering of elective subjects and TechPro specializations aligned with the Provisional Permit/s issued to each SHS implementer.

The Class Programs shall be checked by the CID Supervisors and a report shall be forwarded to this Office through the Quality Assurance Division.

5. Private schools which have crafted their implementation plans may now submit their documents until five days before the opening of their classes.

6. The consolidated SDO reports shall be submitted to this Office **on or before June 30, 2026** via the respective links provided in the attached Enclosure.

7. Immediate dissemination of and compliance with this Memorandum is desired.
