**END-OF-SCHOOL-YEAR (EOSY) TAGGING OF ELECTIVES FOR THE
STRENGTHENED SENIOR HIGH SCHOOL (SSHS) PILOT IMPLEMENTATION**

1. Pursuant to the Advisory from the Policy and Planning Service (PPS) and in accordance with DepEd Memorandum No. 048, s. 2025 titled Pilot Implementation of the Strengthened Senior High School Curriculum for Grade 11 in SY 2025-2026, this Office directs all participating pilot schools to update their Elective Tagging in the Learner Information System (LIS).

2. For the purpose of monitoring the SSHS Curriculum, all pilot schools must ensure the following administrative actions are completed:

- **Correct Reflectance:** Ensure that SSHS tracks, clusters, and electives are accurately reflected in the LIS.
- **Official Enrollment:** Verify that all learners are officially enrolled in their corresponding class offerings.
- **System Alignment:** Align school offerings in both the EBEIS and LIS with the approved listings, as validated by the Regional Planning Officer (RPO) and the Curriculum and Learning Management Division (CLMD).

3. Immediate compliance with this tagging requirement is necessary to facilitate the smooth transition of the pilot implementation and ensure data integrity for the End-of-School-Year reporting.

In accordance with the DepEd Memorandum (DM) No. 048, s. 2025 titled *Pilot Implementation of the Strengthened Senior High School Curriculum for Grade 11 in School Year 2025-2026*, and DM No. 074, s. 2025 titled *Interim Guidelines for the Assessment and Grading System for the Pilot Implementation of the Strengthened Senior High School Curriculum*, all pilot schools participating in the Strengthened Senior High School (SSHS) implementation and their respective Regional Officers (ROs) are hereby directed to update the Elective Tagging.

- Learners are officially enrolled in the corresponding class offerings; and
- School offerings in both the EBEIS and LIS are aligned with approved listings, as guided and validated by the Regional Planning Officer (RPO) and the Curriculum and Learning Management Division (CLMD).
