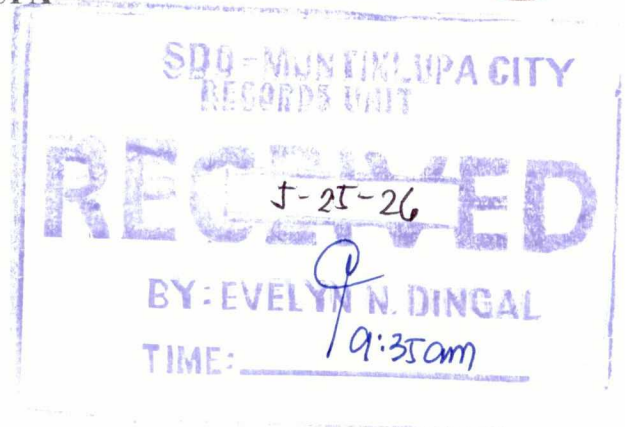

Greetings!


