

Warm greetings of peace and goodwill.

We respectfully submit this proposal to the Schools Division Office seeking approval and partnership to conduct free computerized eye examinations, comprehensive eye examinations, and vision screening for learners in public schools under your jurisdiction.

This initiative is a community-oriented health program aimed at supporting the Department of Education's commitment to learner welfare by addressing visual health concerns that may hinder academic performance, classroom participation, and overall development. Early detection and timely correction of visual problems are essential to ensuring that learners are able to maximize their full learning potential.

This program is aligned with PhilHealth Circular No. 2025-002, which provides that PhilHealth beneficiaries aged zero (0) to fifteen (15) years old, who are assessed and diagnosed by qualified health care professionals to have errors of refraction and other eye conditions correctable by prescription eyeglasses, are eligible to avail of the PhilHealth benefit package for optometric services, including assessments and prescription glasses.

Through this proposed activity, we aim to:

- Provide free eyeglasses to all active member of PhilHealth beneficiary children ages up to 15 years old, free computerized and comprehensive eye examinations, including vision screening, to enrolled learners;
- Identify learners with refractive errors and other correctable eye conditions at an early stage;

- **Assist eligible** learners and their parents or guardians in accessing **PhilHealth** benefits for optometric services and prescription eyeglasses;
- **Contribute** to improved academic performance, learner confidence, and overall well-being through better visual health.

All eye examinations will be conducted by licensed and qualified eye care professionals, adhering strictly to established clinical standards, ethical guidelines, and safety protocols. Prior coordination with school administrators, teachers, parents, and other concerned stakeholders will be ensured to facilitate smooth and orderly implementation of the program.

We firmly believe that this collaborative effort will be a meaningful contribution to community health promotion and learner support, particularly for children who may have limited access to eye care services. In this regard, we respectfully seek the approval and endorsement of the Schools Division Office to implement this program at a time and manner most convenient to your office and participating schools.

Thank you very much for your continued dedication to the welfare of our learners. We look forward to the opportunity to work closely with your office in advancing the visual health and educational success of our students.

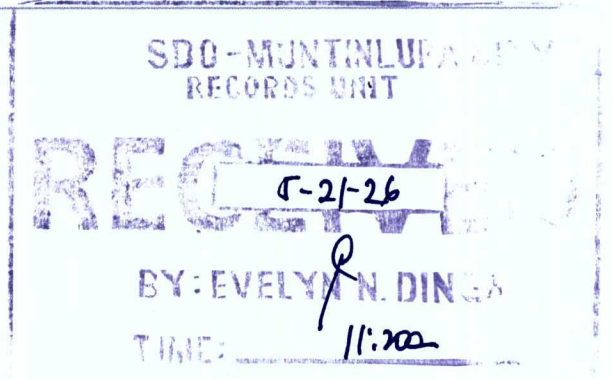
