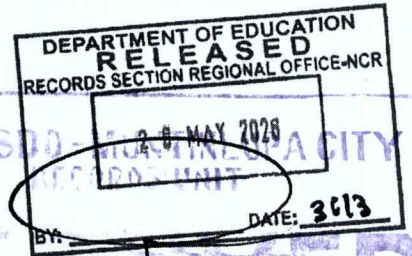

1. This is in reference to Regional Memorandum No. 364 s, 2025 dated May 12, 2026 relative to the conduct of the above-said activity.
2. To ensure the effective delivery of the activity, all participants are hereby informed of the said adjustment. 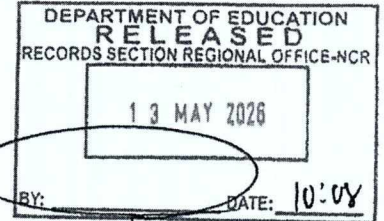

REGIONAL MEMORANDUM

**MINT Through Readers-Mentoring, Inspiring And Nurturing
Key Stage 1 Teachers Through Responsive Education for Advancing
Development In Essential Reading Skills**

1. In line with the DepEd NCR's continuing effort to provide teachers with necessary professional development in emphasizing the pivotal role of KS-1 teachers in enhancing learners' reading skills across salient components of reading across 16 Schools Division Offices, this Office through the Curriculum Learning and Management Division (CLMD), shall conduct the **above-captioned activity** on **May 25 - 29, 2026 and June 1-5, 2026 (exclusive of weekends)**, at designated venues.
2. This regional capacity-building activity, **in partnership with identified Higher Education Institutions (HEIs)**, aims to provide key stage 1 teachers in both pedagogical concepts and practices necessary to ensure coherent, high-quality implementation of reading instructions in key stage 1, aligned with regional priorities on curriculum harmonization, learner-centered environments, and strengthened governance.
3. Specifically, the workshop seeks to accomplish the following objectives:
 - a. **Train selected Grade 1-3 teachers** across all elementary schools in DepEd-NCR on the vital aspects and components of reading instructions.
 - b. Promote **coherence and harmonization** in curriculum delivery particularly in reading instructional practices across Key Stage 1 Levels in the region under the One NCR: Stronger Together framework.
4. Participants are the Key Stage 1 Teachers from 522 Elementary Schools of DepEd- NCR. Identified participants are requested to register to this link: <https://tinyurl.com/39ynp+3t> until **May 20, 2026**. See Enclosure 1 for the allotment of participants per each SDO and Enclosure 2 for the Details of Payment and Activity.
5. Participants are requested to bring their laptops, backup pocket internet connections, and extension cords to be used in the workshops.



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6. Schools Division Offices that will be housed in **Manila Science- SDO Manila and P. Bernardo Elementary School- SDO Quezon City** will pay a registration fee amounting to **Php 13,000.00 per participant** inclusive of meals and training kits. Meanwhile, Schools Division Offices that will be housed in **Far Eastern University and University of Sto. Tomas** will pay a registration fee amounting to **Php 15,000.00 per participant** inclusive of meals, training kits and venue.
7. The registration fee and travel expenses of the participants shall be charged to Division/School MOOE or other local funds, subject to usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
8. Early departures, participant replacements, and late arrivals are strictly **NOT** allowed. In exceptional cases, a formal request duly signed by the School Head, and endorsed by the Schools Division Superintendent, shall be submitted to the Office of the Regional Director for approval prior to the activity.
9. Participants shall be entitled to service credits in accordance with DepEd Order No. 13, s. 2024 entitled *Revised Guidelines for the Grant of Vacation Service Credits for Teachers*. However, non - teaching personnel including Management Staff shall be given with Compensatory Time-Off (CTO) per Civil Service Commission (CSC) and Department of Budget and Management (DBM) Joint Circular No. 2, s. 2004 on Non-Monetary Remuneration for Overtime Service Rendered, specific attention on Section 5.
