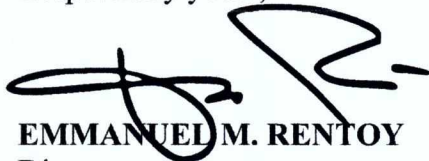

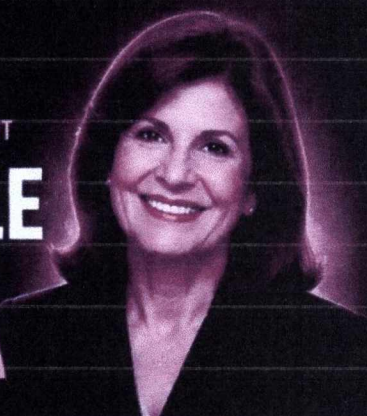

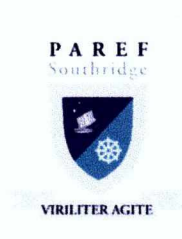
Thanks for taking my call this morning. As instructed, an email was sent to Dr. Gonzales this morning. I am forwarding a copy of the email to you.
