**REITERATION OF POLICIES ON THE SAFE AND RESPONSIBLE USE OF THE
INTERNET AND RELATED DEVICES**

To: Assistant Schools Division Superintendent

Chief Education Supervisor, School Governance and Operations Division
Public Elementary and Secondary School Principals / OICs
All Others Concerned

1. In reference to DepEd Memorandum No. OUOPS-2026-1660 from Atty. Fatima Lipp D. Panontongan, Undersecretary and Chief of Staff, Office of the Secretary, Department of Education, dated June 30, 2026, this Office reiterates the policies on the safe and responsible use of the internet and related devices.
2. Particular attention is directed to the second paragraph, prohibiting the use of portable electronic devices during instructional hours by both learners and personnel, with the exception only for academic purposes and emergencies, if needed.
3. All concerned are enjoined to read **ALL the provisions** of the said issuance to ensure compliance thereof.
4. School heads are enjoined to intensify the campaign on the safe and responsible use of the internet and related devices. Likewise, they are enjoined to implement the aforementioned issuance, including all authorized measures conceived relative to the above subject.
5. Immediate and wide dissemination of this Memorandum is desired.

USE OF THE INTERNET AND RELATED DEVICES**

Pursuant to the Department of Education's (DepEd) commitment to promote and uphold the welfare, safety, security, and protection of all learners and personnel, this Office reiterates the strict implementation of and compliance with existing policies and guidelines concerning the promotion of safe and responsible use of the internet and related devices.

DepEd Order No. 6, s. 2026, titled *Guidelines on Ensuring a Safe and Motivating Learning Environment (ESMLE)*, expressly **prohibits the use of portable electronic devices during instructional hours by both learners and personnel**. However, **exemptions are granted** in meritorious cases, specifically for **academic purposes** (e.g. accessing educational platforms, digital resources, or participating in authorized online collaborative activities) and **emergency situations** (e.g. facilitating communication during disasters, medical crises, or other immediate safety concerns). This includes the prohibition of the usage of, but not limited to, social media, online games, content creation, and vlogging during class hours.

Guided by the ESMLE Framework, a **whole-of-society approach is necessary** in order to **properly guide learners**. Parents, Local Government Units, Police and other Law Enforcement agencies, other government agencies and instrumentalities, Non-Government Organizations/Civil Society Organizations, and all other stakeholders



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each have a collective role to play to ensure that the learners develop responsibility and empathy towards others, even outside the classroom.

In the interest of further promoting the aforementioned values, all field offices and schools are hereby directed to ensure the widest dissemination of these policies to all stakeholders and to **intensify the campaign on the safe and responsible use of the internet and related devices.**
